



Hello Residents,
Please be cautious and courteous of pedestrians and other vehicles when parking close to or near a stop sign.

“Texas Transportation Code says an operator may not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger, stand or park an occupied or unoccupied vehicle in the following places:

- in front of a public or private driveway
- within 15 feet of a fire hydrant
- within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection
- within 30 feet on the approach to a flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a roadway.” (TC 545.302)
